## Locating the Application

EthOS

The 'Shared' tile shows applications that have been shared with you. UG and PGT applicants may choose to share their application with you prior to requesting your signature. This is not where you access their application to provide a signature.

Use the 'Signatures' tile to see a list of applications that have previously had your signature requested.

It is therefore strongly advised that you attend the UG/PGT supervisor training offered for your faculty by the central ethics team.
