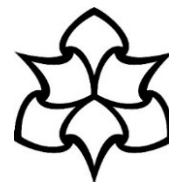

Moodle	<p>The virtual learning environment used by Manchester Met. We maintain three Moodle areas: the PGR Hub, PGR Development and Online Induction.</p> <p>The PGR Hub is one-stop-shop for postgraduate researchers (PGRs) where you can find information about many aspects of the the PGR experience:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Who we are and how to stay in touch</li> <li>• The mandatory Online Induction</li> <li>• Managing your research degree (including the regulations, handbook and key documents)</li> <li>• Careers and employability</li> <li>• Wellbeing and support</li> </ul> <p>PGR Development is a Moodle area dedicated to training and development. You can find out how to take part in events, how to access face-to-face workshops, how to submit articles to our research blog and more.</p> <p>The Online Induction gives an overview of the first three months (if full-time) or six months (if part-time) of your research degree, focusing on the registration process, and provides you with important information that you may need to know during this period.</p> <p>All students are automatically enrolled in the three Moodle areas. P2P	<p>Potentially SciEng only. Academic Year 2019/20.</p> <p>This is the procurement system. Currently students use a separate requisitioning system that is to be phased out academic year 18/19. Procurement relates only to consumables such as chemicals and reagents (travel and IT are not ordered by PGR students.
