2023/24 Employability Work Placement Fee Waivers (UK Full Time Undergraduate Students)

As part of Manchester Met's commitment to **employability and widening participation**, the University will provide a **tuition fee waiver** for up to **250 students** on their **work placement year** in **2023/24**.

This means that **if** you meet the eligibility criteria, the tuition fee for your placement **will be paid for you**.

In order to be eligible for the Employability Fee Waiver, you must meet <u>all</u> the following criteria:

- You are enrolled on a **4 year sandwich degree** spending **Year 3** on placement in the **2023/24** academic year
- You are a self funding student paying tuition fees of **£1,850** (or £1,385 if you are on a full year **work** placement abroad under the Erasmus or Turing scheme)
- You are commencing a **work** placement
- You have a household income as at 31st July 2023 no greater than £25,000 per year
- In the 2022/23 academic year you applied online to be income assessed by Student Finance at <u>http://www.gov.uk/studentfinance</u>
- You have a **UK Student Support Number** (English, Scottish, Welsh and Northern Irish students)

How do I apply?

- You do not need to make a separate application to Manchester Met. All the information we require to assess you for the tuition fee waiver was received when you applied online to Student Finance for your tuition fee loan and maintenance support in 2022/23.
- When you made your application to Student Finance for 2022/23, you must have consented to share your household income details with the University. If your parent(s)/guardian/partner has been income assessed to support your application, they must have given their consent to share as well. If we cannot view your income, we cannot assess you for the fee waiver.

What Happens Next

- If you are eligible for the funding we will advise you during your online enrolment
- If you have applied for a **tuition fee loan** to cover your placement fees (£1,850 or £1,385) **we will contact Student Finance on your behalf** and update them

Terms and Conditions

- You must complete the **full academic year** to be entitled to the funding.
- You must **remain on your work placement year** away from the University. If you **return early** or **transfer to the full time route**, you will **no longer be eligible** for the funding.
- If you **suspend your studies**, you will **not** be eligible for the funding when you **return to your course.**
- If you receive funding which you are **not** entitled to, your University finance account will be adjusted and you will have to **pay for your fees yourself** or by a **tuition fee loan**.
- You will be eligible for **one** tuition fee waiver only. No further funding will be given in the event you have to **repeat** your placement year.
- Tuition fee waivers will only fund your placement year where fees are **£1,850** (or £1,385 for those on a **work** placement abroad under the Erasmus or Turing schemes) and will **not** cover repeating **school or social work placements**.
- Employability tuition fee waivers will not be processed retrospectively if your household income is amended or consent to share is approved after 31st July 2023. All tuition fee waivers will only be processed in the academic year they relate to.
