

Terms and conditions: Lee Kai Hung International Talent Scholarships 2023/24

This document sets out the Terms and Conditions applicable to the Lee Kai Hung International Talent Scholarships 2023/24. Please read them carefully and keep a copy for your records.

If, following a successful application, you are offered an award, you will be deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions on receipt of the scholarship.

Withdrawal of the scholarship

The University may withdraw the scholarship if:

- You are subsequently found to be ineligible for the scholarship; or
- These Terms and Conditions are not met in full; or
- You do not meet all conditions attached to your offer of a place at the University; or
- You fail to meet the conditions set out below.

If your scholarship is withdrawn it will be cancelled, and you will be required to repay the scholarship in full/full tuition fees will be due.

Applicant and course eligibility criteria

- This scholarship offer is limited to applicants, who have completed their undergraduate degree at a University in Mainland China or Hong Kong.
- In order to apply, applicants must hold an unconditional or a conditional offer for an eligible Master's programme at Manchester Metropolitan University, starting in January 2024.
- Only the courses listed <u>below</u>, and being taught at Manchester Metropolitan University Campus, are eligible.
- If a student holds a conditional offer at the time they make their scholarship application, the award can only be granted once the offer conditions have been met.
- Applicants must be self-funding and classified as overseas students for tuition fee purposes.
- Applicants must have successfully met any conditions set for entry onto the programme.
- In addition to a strong personal statement, submitted as part of the scholarship application process, applicants must also meet the minimum academic requirements to be considered for the scholarship.
- Minimum academic requirements for students who have completed their Bachelor degree at a university in Mainland China are the completion of a Bachelor's degree with an average score of 75% (equivalent to a 2:1 class UK degree).
- Minimum academic requirements for students who have completed their Bachelor degree at a university in Hong Kong are the completion of a Bachelor's degree with a GPA of 2.7 or Second Class Honours Upper Division classification (equivalent to a 2:1 class UK degree).
- Scholarship offers will only be made once academic qualifications are confirmed and verified.
- Scholarships are awarded by the Scholarship Panel, their decision is final and cannot be appealed.

Other conditions

- Only candidates who have submitted a complete scholarship application, and who meet the minimum academic conditions, will be considered for the scholarship.
 The deadline for applications is 30th November 2023.
- Applications selected to receive a scholarship offer must confirm that they accept the award, by replying to the scholarship offer email, within 7 days.
- A scholarship offer must be accepted by the given deadline. Where an offer of a scholarship
 is not accepted by the given deadline, it is automatically revoked unless otherwise agreed
 with the University.
- Applicants nominated for the scholarship may be asked to submit their full academic transcripts, and other supporting documents, before the scholarship offer is confirmed.
- The scholarship will be awarded as a reduction in tuition fees for overseas students commencing their studies in Academic Year 2023/24 and is available for one year only.
- The scholarship is only available in the year of study when the full overseas fee is charged.
- Any scholarship awarded should be displayed during a student's online enrolment, however
 if the University's Finance Office are aware, when processing the invoice (or afterwards), that
 they are not a self-funding student the Scholarship will be removed and standard overseas
 fees will apply.
- If a student is in receipt of more than one form of fee reduction, including discounts, awards or scholarship they will only receive one fee reduction and will be awarded the greater amount.
- No other form of Manchester Metropolitan University discount or scholarship may be used in conjunction with the Lee Kai Hung International Talent Scholarships. Please refer to the Regulations for the Payment of University Fees for further information on how discounts/scholarships are applied by clicking here.
- Students will not be eligible for the full scholarship if they do not complete the full course
 which results in a fee reduction. If they withdraw, suspend or exit with a lesser award the
 Regulations for the Payment of University Fees state discount/scholarships will be pro-rated
 if the withdrawal, suspension or exit results in a reduced tuition fee. In these cases, the value
 of any scholarship will be pro-rated in proportion to any reduced tuition fees.
- Should a student transfer courses or change their study mode they might be required to repay the scholarship in full.
- If a student suspends from the course which results in a fee reduction, the value of any award will be pro-rated in proportion to the tuition fees charged. The remaining scholarship will be applied in the following academic year providing students return to their eligible course and the scholarships are still available.
- If a student fails to pay fees as agreed, any amount awarded may be reversed and they might need to pay the full fee amount.
- Should a student leave their course due to unavoidable circumstances, they will need to
 provide evidence by email to <u>internationalscholarships@mmu.ac.uk.</u>. This evidence will then
 be considered by the University. Manchester Metropolitan University may, at its discretion,
 pro-rata eligibility for the scholarship depending on the student's date of
 suspension/withdrawal.
- The scholarship will not be carried over if a student defers entry, beyond the 2023/24 academic year.
- Please note that all students are required to comply with, and are bound by, the University's Student Regulations and Procedures, which can be viewed at www.mmu.ac.uk/policy. If a



- student is removed from the course for failing to comply with the Student Regulations and Procedures, or the student Terms and Conditions provided at offer or enrolment, they will be required to pay the scholarship back in full.
- The University reserves the right to amend its scholarship provision without notice. The Scholarship Terms and Conditions will continue even if a scholarship recipient is no longer registered as a University Student. For example, the conditions related to repayment of scholarship award or any obligations agreed to be undertaken following completion of the course will still apply.
- By accepting a Scholarship, the student agrees to their name, and subject of study being shared with the benefactor. In addition, students will be required to write short updates on their studies, and their experience at the University, which will be shared with the benefactor.
- All scholarship holders may be invited to meet the benefactor in Manchester or China, either during their studies or after graduation.
- Whilst a student at the University, the successful applicant will also be asked to attend, participate, and contribute to a range of activities and events that help to market and promote the impact of fundraising.
- These Terms and Conditions do not constitute a relationship between us of partnership, joint venture, principal or agent. They are between the scholarship recipient and the University, and no other person shall have any rights to enforce any of their terms.
- These Terms and Conditions will be governed by the laws of England and Wales and we both submit to the Courts of England Wales.
- Successful applicants will be invited to join the International Student Representative Scheme
 and provide support to the China Office team with projects (for example participation in predeparture events) during their studies and on graduation, the scholars will be invited to
 contribute to the projects of Manchester Met's alumni community.
