Teachers and Careers Advisers Conference

- Entry requirements and selection procedures reviewed annually
- Use of the UCAS tariff (some exceptions)
- Up to three A level-equivalent qualifications accepted towards entry
- Consideration of 'non-standard' profiles
- Consideration of mitigating circumstances

- 'Straight-to-decision' courses
- Courses requiring an audition
- Courses requiring a portfolio
- Courses requiring an **interview**



Common reasons for an unsuccessful outcome:

- Level 3 subject requirements
- Level 2 requirements
- Predicted grades
- Additional selection criteria for professional/creative courses
- Applicant not responding to request for further information
- Submission of application after UCAS equal consideration deadline

Application outcomes

Factors affecting speed of decision-making:

- Application submission date
- Query re. achieved or pending qualifications*
- Query re. permanent residence/ fee status*
- Additional selection/ assessment stages
- Self-declaration for courses requiring DBS clearance
- Delayed response to request for further information

Tips to support the application process:

- Ensure applicant has checked **all** requirements
- Are listed qualifications full and accurate?*
- Inclusion of third party nominated access
- Email address with regular and continued access
- Use of Learning Records Service

- Reply swaps
- Deferral requests

Reasons for Pending Confirmation

- 'Missing' or pending results
- Verification of qualifications required
- Outstanding DBS and occupational health clearance
- Other outstanding non-academic conditions

Confirmation and Clearing

- 'UCC' decisions student action required
- Requests to change course after confirmation
- Requests to defer after confirmation
- Requests to be released while still CF/ CI
- Appealing a confirmation decision
- Applying through Clearing
