

POLICE REGISTRATION

Where do I start?

If your visa states “Police Registration / Register with Police within 7 days” then you must make an appointment to register with the Police within 7 days of your arrival in the UK, or within 7 days of your Biometric Permit (BRP) being issued. Sometimes the appointment itself will not occur within 7 days but making the appointment within this limit satisfies the requirement.

Generally, you will not need to register if you are a Commonwealth or EU citizen.

If you studied in the UK previously and have received a Police Registration Certificate in the past, please have the certificate number and name of police force with which you registered.

How do I book an appointment

Students who need to register should make their appointment at the Information Desk during the International Welcome programme. Students arriving after that should email internationalwelcome@mmu.ac.uk to arrange their appointment.

If you are living in Crewe, you can book a Police Registration appointment by calling +44 (0)1244 350000 or email registration@cheshire.pnn.police.uk

Take the following to your appointment

- Your passport
- Your CAS statement/MMU offer letter
- Two recent passport size photographs
- Proof of your Crewe or Manchester address
- Your completed Police Registration Form, **see below.**
- Your Biometric Residence Permit (if you have one)
- Registration fee, payable in cash if applying in Crewe but can be paid by cash or debit card if registering in Manchester.

If you move, change marital or civil partnership status, extend your visa or a variety of other situations you must report these.
